



## **Carol Combs Hole Conference Attendance Grant**

Carol Combs Hole provided exemplary leadership on behalf of libraries, bookmobile and outreach services throughout her 32 year career as a professional public librarian. She retired from distinguished service to the Alachua County Library District on March 1, 2006 and died on October 1, 2007.

The grant includes free conference registration and a stipend (about \$600) for his/her travel expenses and/or accommodations for the conference. The stipend will be mailed to the grant recipient within two weeks after his/her attendance at the conference.

The winner automatically will be registered for the conference.

### **Criteria for Selecting Grant Recipients**

The Carol Combs Hole Conference Attendance Grant Committee will consider the following criteria in the selection of the recipient of this grant:

1. The applicant must be employed in a public library, working in bookmobile or outreach services at the time the application is submitted.
2. The completed application form and attached narrative must be received prior to the deadline printed on the form.
3. The applicant is not eligible to apply for the grant again for five years.
4. The applicant does not need to be a member of the Association of Bookmobile and Outreach Services at the time their application is submitted.
